

ATTENTION COMMERCIAL VEHICLE OPERATORS!

Significant changes coming to your daily use of Level 5

Starting in May 2012, commercial vehicle operators will experience significant changes to how you circulate on Level 5 as well as where you drop-off passengers.

STARTING MAY 5, 2012 AT 2 A.M.

- The South Terminal Level 5 Return Road will permanently close

STARTING MAY 19, 2012 AT 2 A.M.


- **All access to Level 5 will be made from the east**
 - All traffic will exit west using the Airport Office Building (AOB) Access Road, which will go one-way westbound
- **There will no longer be curbside drop-off**
 - All drop-offs and pick-ups will be in current designated median locations on Level 5 East and West
- **RTD bus and Pikes Peak/Mt. Elbert shuttle passenger drop-off and pick-up will move to Level 6 East**

WHY IS THIS HAPPENING?

In addition to overall construction on the South Terminal Redevelopment Program, DIA is reconstructing the south Level 4, 5 and 6 bridges. The Program will complete the original vision of DIA, which includes adding a 500-room Westin hotel and a Public Transit Center to house the RTD East Rail Line station connecting DIA to downtown Denver.
